We are excited about changes at Medical Journal of Therapeutics Africa (MJoTA), <http://www.mjota.org>. The first issue was published on 15 January 2007: the following 4 issues were published every 4 months and since June, 2 to 4 articles have been published each month. On 15 January 2009 the first articles in vol 3 of MJoTA will be published, after then, MJoTA will be published monthly [with daily updates on mjota.org](http://www.mjota.org).

The mission of MJoTA is to publish articles that celebrate science and health professionals working in the health industries, particularly in the pharmaceutical industry. MJoTA's goal is to support visionary professionals who are working towards creating a complete and indigenous pan-African pharmaceutical industry. We welcome articles from US and African health and health industry professionals.

MJoTA trains medical writers online! The first 2 courses ([MW1 and RW1](#)) are aimed at finding medical writing jobs for health and science professionals. Over 3 months the MJoTA faculty work with students on resumes and on 3 articles for publication in MJoTA. These articles are reviewed by members of the MJoTA Editorial Board, as are all articles in MJoTA.

MJoTA additionally offers 3 webinar courses; a series of 4 weekly webinars with pre-and post-webinar writing assignments and tests: training IND/NDA FDA documentation ([RW2](#)), writing medical journal articles, magazine articles, health data and presentations ([MW2](#)), and health topics ([MW3](#)).

MJoTA will form classes at your convenience and your time-zone, all classes have maximally 6 students, and run with 2 to 3 students. More information on <http://mjota.org>.
